TUITION AND SCHOOL FEES COLLECTION

2025-2026

For 2025-2026, Nativity of Our Lord School will collect tuition and fees through FACTS, our tuition management company. FACTS provides various methods of payment that allow for the most flexibility for our families while saving steps and time for the staff involved in tuition management and enrollment. These fees are billed under the **Incidental Billing platform** in FACTS and will have their own billing due dates that <u>may not</u> coincide with your contracted tuition due date.

Below is a list of the current school fees that will be collected through the FACTS Incidental Billing system that will appear on your FACTS account in the months when they are due.

Please be aware that if your tuition is paid in full in July, you will still receive invoices for these fees in August and September and will be part of your total financial responsibility.

All CARES fees for before/after school care will also be billed using the Incidental Billing platform in FACTS.

You may register a credit card for automatic payment of Incidental Billing charges but it is not required. You may send payments for Incidental Billing invoices directly to FACTS if desired.

2025-2026 School Fees (partial list-subject to change)

All Full Day Students:

Lunch Activity/Monitor Fee: \$75.00 per year PER FAMILY - billed in July 2025

All Students:

- Technology Fee: \$25 per student billed to all accounts in September 2025
- Art & Stationery Fee: per student billed to all accounts in August 2025
 - PreK3: \$90 per year
 - PreK4: \$70 per year
 - Kindergarten: \$75 per year
 - Grade 1: \$60 per year
 - Grade 2: \$60 per year (includes magazine subscription)
 - Grade 3: \$30 per year
 - Grade 4: \$40 per year (includes magazine subscriptions)
 - Grade 5: \$25 per year
 - Grade 6: \$20 per year
 - Grade 7: \$15 per year
 - Grade 8: \$35 per year (includes yearbook)
- Grade 8 Students: Graduation Fee To be determined later in the school year, billed in 2 installments March & April, 2026.

These fees will appear on your account balance when they are due to be charged. All fees become part of the total account responsibility and are payable at published due dates. Unpaid balances for fees are considered part of the total account responsibility and grades, report cards, privileges (such as class trips), transfer of records, can be withheld pending payment in full of all outstanding balances.
